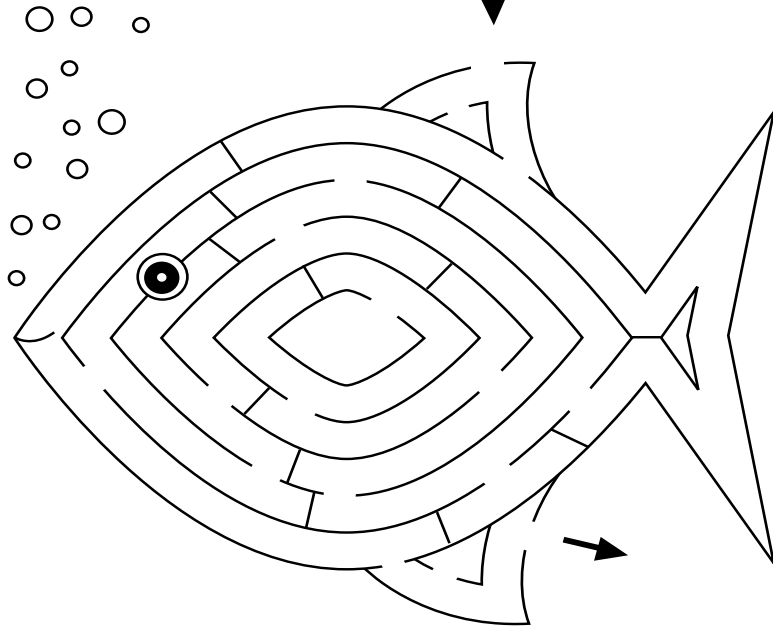


MAZE CRAZE

Let's pray for our leaders in Haiti

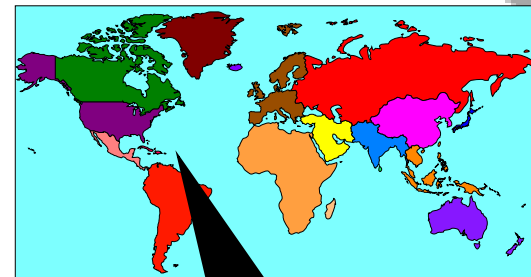

LET'S LEARN ABOUT CHILDREN

IN HAITI & JAMAICA:

What do the kids in Haiti & Jamaica eat?

Kids in Haiti eat mainly rice and beans or melons and bananas. Kids in Jamaica have a little more variety to their meals (See meals box)



FOOD IN JAMAICA:

Breakfast: Porridge: Mashed bananas with some cinnamon sprinkled on top

Lunch: Patty: A meat pie

Dinner: Rice and peas along with callaloo (greens) or **Plantain** (fried banana-like fruit)

Let's learn some Jamaican Words!

GNEPS A grape-like fruit that has a tart taste

GAZARDA Fried coconut tarts

BULLA BREAD bread made with coco flour

What food would be their favorite?

Anything sweet is a favorite on both islands. *Haitian children* enjoy peanut brittle!

Jamaicans especially like "sweeties" (candy from the U.S.).

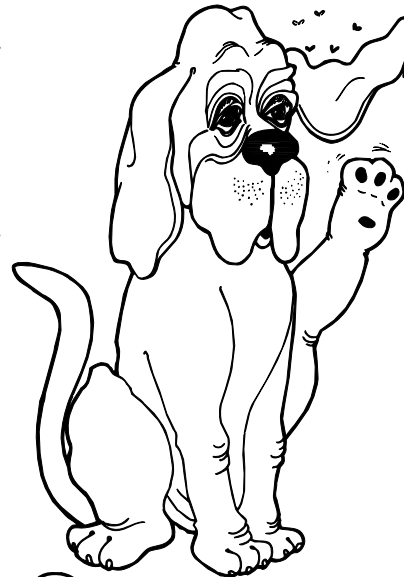
Do they get special treats?

For *Haitian children*, meat is a special food. Most don't have meat in their daily diets. For *Jamaicans*, they enjoy Gneps, Gazarda and any sweet candies from

ISLAND PETS:

On Jamaica, the children often have parrots or chameleons as pets. Children on both Haiti and Jamaica have dogs.

Do all children get to go to school?

Children in Haiti have very primitive schools. They use a chalk board and do a lot of memorization because not many families can afford books, paper or pencils.

Children in Jamaica got to school and wear a uniform with the colors of their school. In both countries, everyone can attend school until the 6th or 8th grades. In Jamaica, they then take an examination to enter higher learning.

What games to they like to play?

In Haiti, the children don't have many toys so, they make up games and have races, especially swimming races!

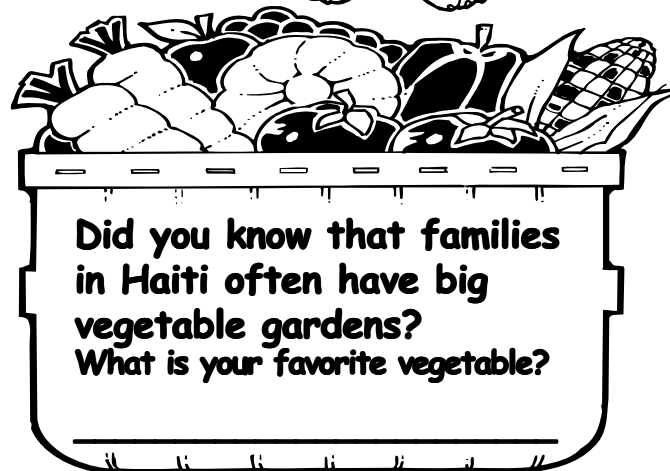
Jamaican children really like cricket, soccer and basketball.

In Haiti, a family with 4-5 children will live in a little house as big as the average living room in America.
