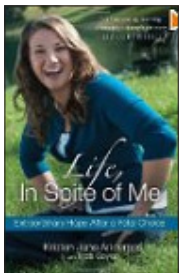

1. Life In Spite of Me

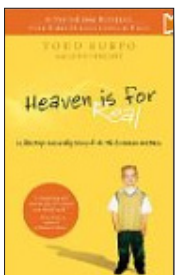

2. Heaven is For Real

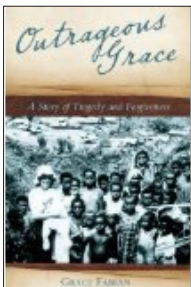

3. Outrageous Grace

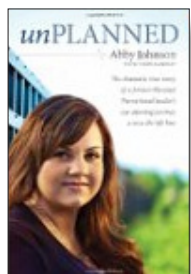

4. Unplanned

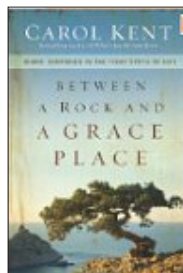

5. Between A Rock and A Grace Place

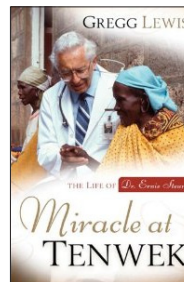

6. Miracle At Tenwek

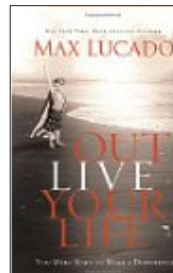

7. Outlive Your Life: You Were Made to Make A Difference

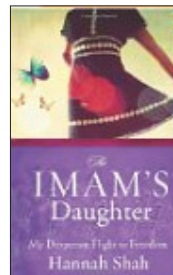

8. The Imam's Daughter

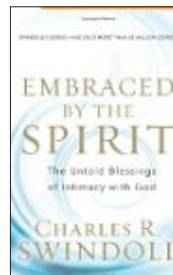

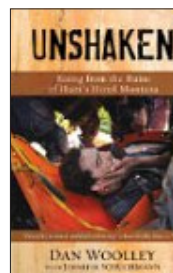
